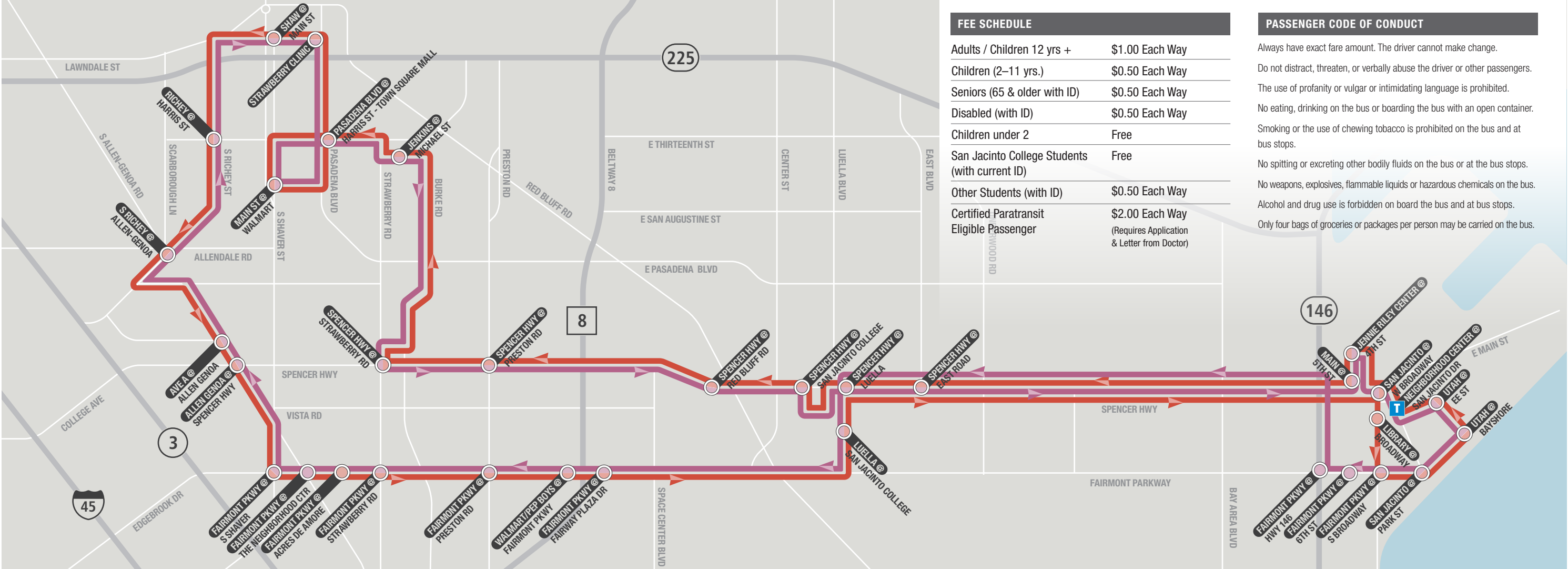

FEE SCHEDULE

Adults / Children 12 yrs +	\$1.00 Each Way
Children (2-11 yrs.)	\$0.50 Each Way
Seniors (65 & older with ID)	\$0.50 Each Way
Disabled (with ID)	\$0.50 Each Way
Children under 2	Free
San Jacinto College Students (with current ID)	Free
Other Students (with ID)	\$0.50 Each Way
Certified Paratransit Eligible Passenger	\$2.00 Each Way (Requires Application & Letter from Doctor)

PASSENGER CODE OF CONDUCT

- Always have exact fare amount. The driver cannot make change.
- Do not distract, threaten, or verbally abuse the driver or other passengers.
- The use of profanity or vulgar or intimidating language is prohibited.
- No eating, drinking on the bus or boarding the bus with an open container.
- Smoking or the use of chewing tobacco is prohibited on the bus and at bus stops.
- No spitting or excreting other bodily fluids on the bus or at the bus stops.
- No weapons, explosives, flammable liquids or hazardous chemicals on the bus.
- Alcohol and drug use is forbidden on board the bus and at bus stops.
- Only four bags of groceries or packages per person may be carried on the bus.

ROUTE SYSTEM



T La Porte to Baytown Transfer Point
 Shuttle Bus service beginning in Baytown on the half hour at 7:00 AM until 5:00 PM. Service is from the Baytown transfer point at Park and Garth Road to the La Porte Neighborhood Center on San Jacinto street.

San Jacinto College Bus Stops
 Spencer Highway buses will stop at the Advanced Interactive Learning Center building on the San Jacinto Campus; Fairmont Parkway buses will make "courtesy" stops at Oakhaven and Schochler Dr. on the San Jacinto Campus on a time available basis.

HANDICAPPED ACCESSIBILITY
 All buses are equipped with lifts for those who are disabled. When a bus approaches, the driver will align the wheelchair lift with the passenger and the driver will provide assistance in boarding.

Special Services
 For those individuals with disabilities certified as eligible according to the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Harris County Transit provides curb to curb service within 3/4 of a mile on each side of a bus route. Call 713-578-2216 for details and an application.
