The license must be valid through the program duration.</li> <li>Be currently employed as a professional nurse (Employment verification required).</li> <li>Submit one recommendation letter from the employer (supervisor) or former nursing faculty.</li> <li>Drug Screening</li> <li>Criminal Background Check</li> <li>Immunizations &amp; Health Insurance</li> <li>CPR Certification Healthcare Provider</li> <li>Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.</li> <li>Upon entry into the program, students must complete the following: Initiate an account with CastleBranch Program Code (JC18dtim)</li> </ul>
