

Program Objectives

Starting in the Fall of 2011, San Jacinto College Central department of theatre and film will be offering video/film acting and production. A new associate of arts degree in film/video production will also be offered. This is a unique program, and the only one of its kind in Texas, a program that blends training in live theatre and recorded media (film). Our students will now be able to direct, construct and/or perform in stage productions, as well as, write, produce and/or act in their own videos. In lieu of a fifth production in our season, a departmental film will be produced and entered into national and international film festivals.

Due to the increasing demand for film employment in the Houston area, San Jacinto College Central has renovated their facilities to accommodate the need. The department has several new facilities, including an 874-square-foot production studio with four XL2 cameras, 5 HD cameras, clear-com communication, separate lighting grid, and blue screen. New video equipment is also housed in a separate control room, post production room (with four G5 editing bays), and a 609-square-foot classroom (with electric screen and ceiling mounted projector). The 1,000-seat Slocomb Auditorium and the 175-seat Powell Theatre have also been re-designed to allow for conversion into back-up video/film studios.

Heading the new program's direction, will be film acting instructor Dr. Jerry Ivins, and local film-maker Ms. Molly Vernon. Ms. Vernon has worked professionally and taught both theatre and film locally in the Houston area. She has traveled the world with her students and performed in Europe, Norway, and Japan, and is an award winning writer and filmmaker. Her narrative feature screenplay "Trashman" is optioned and slated to shoot soon. Her screenplays "Ashes In The Storm" and "The Business Trip" are in negotiation with studios. The program have seven full-time individuals on our artistic team!!

Professional film: actor, director, producer, production assistant, cinematographer, digital editor, gaffer, sound, special effects, makeup design, set construction, casting agent

Arts administration: public relations director, festival coordinator, artistic director, business manager, special events coordinator, program planner

Education: teach areas that include film acting, digital editing, film production, construction, lighting, sound

General business: fashion designer, interior designer, color analyst, sales representative, product demonstrator, property manager, spokesperson, personal manager, advertising executive, convention and meeting coordinator, program planner

Entertainment industry: lightboard programmer, sound engineer, audio visual (examples: concerts, churches, amusement parks)
