

DOL H-1B Ready to Work Grant

Frequently asked Questions

(FAQS)

1. Who is the targeted population?

The targeted population are individuals who are unemployed or have been *underemployed for 27 weeks or longer.

2. Do I have to be a U.S. Citizen to participate in the grant?

No you do not. Permanent Residents are also able to participate in the grant.

3. What do I need from Workforce Solutions?

You will need to provide your www.workintexas.com "Homepage" from Workforce Solutions.

4. Do I have to buy books for grant sponsored trainings?

For most cases no. Most grant participants will have their books paid for.

5. If I am a male, do I have to register for Selective Service to participate in the grant?

No you do not. If you are younger than 26 years of age, you can still register for Selective Service. If you are not sure if you registered, you can check at www.sss.gov.

6. Do I have to have a High School Diploma?

No you do not. You can have a GED or High School equivalent to participate. If you do not have a GED, please [click here](#) to find out how to obtain one.

*An individual who lost their job during or after the recent recession (commencing from Dec. 1, 2007 forward) and have obtained only episodic, short-term, or part-time employment but have not reconnected with a full-time commensurate with the individual's level of education, skills and previous wage or salary earned prior to the individual's loss of permanent employment for 27 consecutive weeks
