San Jacinto College in partnership with ASQ chapter 1422 is offering the ASQ Quality Improvement Associate Certification Exam Review course, designed to prepare students to take the ASQ Quality Improvement Associate Certification Exam. Students will be expected to spend additional time studying prior to taking the test.

Four domains will be covered – Quality Concepts, Team Basics, Continuous Improvement Techniques, and Customer-Supplier Relations.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

To identify basic quality concepts as described in the Quality Improvement Associate Body of Knowledge. To identify testing format and approaches to test-taking.

ASQ Quality Improvement Associate Certification

ASQ designed this certification for an individual who has a basic knowledge of quality tools and their uses and is involved in quality improvement projects, but doesn't necessarily come from a traditional quality area.

Education and/or Experience

The applicant must have two years of work experience, or an Associate's Degree or two years of equivalent higher education.
