Building Naming

\$2 million



The Generation Park Campus' first building is a 55,000-square-foot instructional facility prominently angled at the intersection of Lockwood Road and West Lake Houston Parkway. This beautiful modern building is within walking distance of West Lake and a surrounding trail system.

Lobby Area



The spacious downstairs lobby with grand staircase and yellow-and-gray geometric feature wall includes a welcome desk with two computers and chairs, benches, and tables for relaxing and mingling.

Student Lounge Area

Naturally-lit upstairs lounge offers bench-lined windows and clusters of tables and chairs for socializing and studying. The space also includes bar-style seating with eight chairs.

Student Success Center

The Student Success Center offers tutoring services and a library for students for research and academic support. The center includes a Wepa print station, five tables, and 14 computers, along with two private study rooms.


Biology/Geology Lab

\$100,000

1 Available

This window-lined lab seats 32 students at eight lab tables. Students engage in hands-on biology and geology experiments with equipment ranging from a Heratherm[™] compact microbiological incubator to 25 Leica microscopes. The room also includes a goggle sanitizing station, a projector, a pull-down screen, a whiteboard, and a document camera.

Chemistry Lab





This window-lined lab seats 32 students, with 32 computers mounted at eight lab tables. The room contains traditional and state-of-the-art chemistry lab equipment, including four Venturi fume hoods, four Mettler scales, eight MicroLAB Model 528-T (Titration) Packages, a goggle sanitizing station, a projector, a pull-down screen, and a whiteboard.

Lab Prep and Storage Area

\$100,000

This combined lab and prep/storage area contains modern equipment for varied chemistry experiments. It includes a computer station, a reach-in CO2 incubator, an ice machine, a refrigerator/freezer, a goggle sanitizing station, a Heratherm[™] oven, a Venturi fume hood, three flammable cabinets, and a Mettler scale.

Active Learning Computer Lab

\$100,000

4 Available

This lab offers hands-on learning for up to 32 students. The room includes 32 computers and a podium with an instructor computer, along with a printer, a projector, a pull-down screen, and a whiteboard.

Testing Room



1 Available

This room accommodates testing for up to 40 students. It contains 40 computers, along with a podium, a projector, a pull-down screen, and a whiteboard.

Large Classroom



1 Available

Wrapped in tall windows for natural light, this room seats 64 students and contains two projectors, two pull-down screens, a podium with instructor computer, and a whiteboard.
