IMMUNIZATIONS	DESCRIPTION
Tetanus-diphtheria (Tdap):	<input type="checkbox"/> Vaccine Proof of 1 dose less than 10 years old. If more than 10 yrs old, a booster is required.
Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR):	<input type="checkbox"/> #1 Vaccine <input type="checkbox"/> #2 Vaccine Or <input type="checkbox"/> Titer Proof of 2 doses. If previously vaccinated and shot records are lost or unavailable, immunity can be validated with a titer level (blood) confirmation.
Hepatitis B (Hep. B)	<input type="checkbox"/> #1 Vaccine <input type="checkbox"/> #2 Vaccine <input type="checkbox"/> #3 Vaccine Or <input type="checkbox"/> Titer If previously vaccinated and shot record lost or unavailable, immunity can be validated with a titer level (blood) confirmation. <i>Please note that series takes 4-6 months to complete.</i>
Varicella (Chickenpox):	<input type="checkbox"/> #1 Vaccine <input type="checkbox"/> #2 Vaccine Or <input type="checkbox"/> Titer
Influenza Vaccine (Flu Shot)	<input type="checkbox"/> Seasonal Flu Shot Flu vaccines are good for the current flu season.
TB Skin Test (TB/PPD)	<input type="checkbox"/> TB Test (<1 year) Or <input type="checkbox"/> Chest X-Ray (< 1 year) If you have had a previous positive TB skin test or the BCG (TB) vaccination you must have a chest x-ray performed. TB Skin Tests and Chest X-Rays are good for 1 year.

*Depending on the affiliation site additional vaccines or the need to repeat vaccines may be required.
