Applicants who are transferring in college credits from another college must show proof of approved SJCD transfer credits with the application. Please submit a degree evaluation from SOS. Students must pass ALL prerequisite courses with a grade of "C" or better.**

III. Admission Criteria Options (recommended but not required to apply)

- a.) Graduate of a 2-year Allied Healthcare Program (Radiography, Respiratory, Paramedic, Nursing, Occupational Therapy, or Surgical Technology)
- b.) Bachelor's Degree (any major)
- c.) LVN Graduate
- d.) CNA +2 years work experience
- e.) 3+ years direct patient care work experience

IV. Computer Literacy

Computer proficiency is recommended for the Sonography Program. Students who do not have computer proficiency are encouraged to take BCIS 1305 Business Computer Applications or ITSC 1309 Integrated Software Applications I.
