Prerequisite: Reading level 6 (4:3-2)

Prerequisites: SPAN 1411-1412 (3:3-0)

It continues basic Spanish language skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing within a cultural framework. Students acquire the vocabulary and grammatical structures necessary to communicate and comprehend at the high beginner to low intermediate level. Prerequisite: SPAN 1411 (4:3-2)

Spanish 2312 Intermediate All Online

It is a continuation of Spanish 2311. Although no lab is scheduled, students will have access to tapes and other lab materials and will be encouraged to use these supplemental learning tools. Prerequisite: SPAN 2311 (3:3-0)
