Transfer courses and course substitutions:

Transferred courses from other colleges must appear in the pre-requisite sections on the GPS as requirement met. If the humanities/fine arts, PSYC 2301, BIOL 2301/2101, BIOL 2302/2102 or ENGL 1301 appear as a GENE elective, the applicant must submit a course substitution to the appropriate Department Chair prior to applying for the program.

Course substitution requests for MATH 1314 must be approved by the Medical Imaging Department Chair prior to applying for the program. MATH 1314 can only be substituted by a higher-level math such as MATH 2314. The following courses will not be considered for substitution: MATH 1316, 1324, 1332, or 1342.
