

Application for Carl Perkins Child Care Program

San Jacinto College District

Program Rules

- I. Completion of admission requirements for San Jacinto College is necessary before an application can be considered for the program. This program is designed to support nontraditional participation and completion of CTE programs and those students that meet special/unique circumstance criteria.
- II. The amount of individual funding available for child care services will be calculated based on student need. Qualified applicants may receive full or partial child care funding, depending on availability of grant funds. You will be responsible for any amount that exceeds the grant coverage. Actual amount funded will depend on the student's class schedule and grant funding availability.
- III. A student must be currently enrolled in a technical program before an application can be approved.
- IV. Approval Process and Documentation Required
 - a. Student must be major in a San Jacinto College technical or health science program.
 - b. Completed application of the Carl Perkins Child Care Program.
 - c. Completed SJC Vendor Set-up packet with direct deposit form (*if being directly reimbursed for child care expenses*)
 - d. Transcript: applicant must provide a copy of his/her transcript. A GPA of 2.0 or higher is required for acceptance and continuation into the program.
 - e. Paid fee receipt/schedule
- V. Additional stipulations
 - a. All awards are contingent upon available funding. Award is subject to cancellation when funds are no longer available.
 - b. In order to receive childcare funding, child(ren) must be in one of the San Jacinto College children's centers or an alternate daycare facility. Any childcare facility to be paid or reimbursed must be licensed.
 - c. Applicants must immediately notify the Dean via email of any changes in class schedule. Failure to do so may result in immediate discontinuation of funding and the applicant will be liable for all charges incurred.
